### tasting notes

Gorgeous crimson colour. Lightly spicy and delicately berried on the nose and palate. The initial mouthfeel is quite sumptuous, but this elegant Shiraz finishes fairly dry. A good accompaniment to light red meat dishes or ostrich, oxtail and venison.

### in the vineyard

The moderate climate and fertile soils, combined with cooling winds in the afternoons, create ideal conditions for growing quality red grapes.

### about the harvest

The grapes were harvested in February 2001 from a vineyard situated on clay soil in the Muldersvlei area in Stellenbosch. The grapes were harvested fully ripe.
